

Decoupage Kit How-To Guide



Step-by-Step Guide:

1. Prepare your surface

- Make sure your item is clean and dry.
- Lightly sand if needed to add a key/slightly rough surface.

2. Cut out your designs

- Carefully cut out the shapes or images you want to use. (If you are using napkins, use only the top layer).

3. Arrange your design

- Lay out your cutouts on your item to see how it looks before gluing.

4. Apply craft glue

- Lift each cut out one at a time and use a brush to apply a thin layer of craft glue on the area where your paper will go. Then put the cut out back in place. Repeat for additional cut outs, or layers.

5. Smooth the paper

- Smooth out wrinkles and bubbles gently with your fingers or a soft brush.

6. Seal it

- Brush another thin layer of craft glue over the top of the paper to seal it.
- Let it dry completely.
- Once dry, you can add the clear craft varnish for extra protection and shine.

8. Let it dry completely

- Wait at least a few hours (or overnight) before using or handling your decorated item.

Materials You'll Need:

- Item to decorate (wood, glass, tin, or cardboard work well)
- Paper or napkins with designs you like
- Decoupage/craft glue or watered-down PVA
- Paintbrushes
- Scissors
- Sandpaper (optional for add a key/slightly rough surface)
- Clear craft varnish



Tips:

- Separate napkin layers before use. Use the top, printed layer.
- **Work slowly, paper tears easily!**
- Layer papers for creative effects.
